



RECOMMENDED GATES

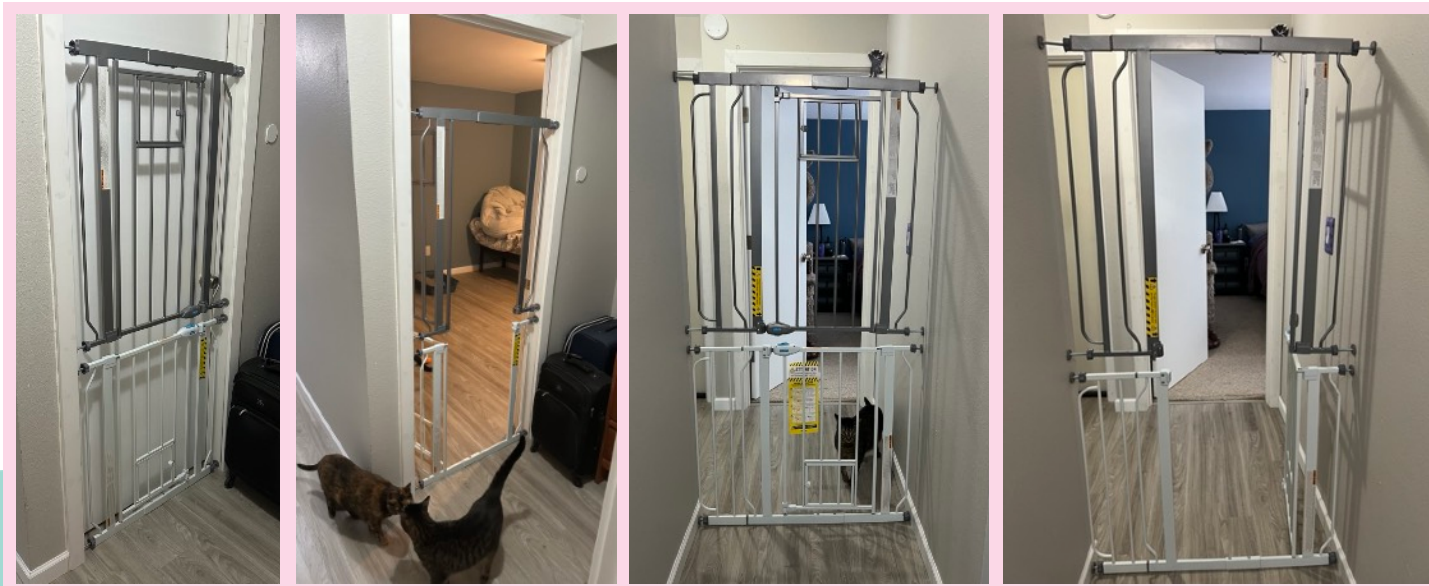
BEST RECOMMENDATION:

Two gates stacked and flipped so doors line up

Pro - can have a door to come and go, installed with tension

Con - it won't work for kittens as they can walk between the rods

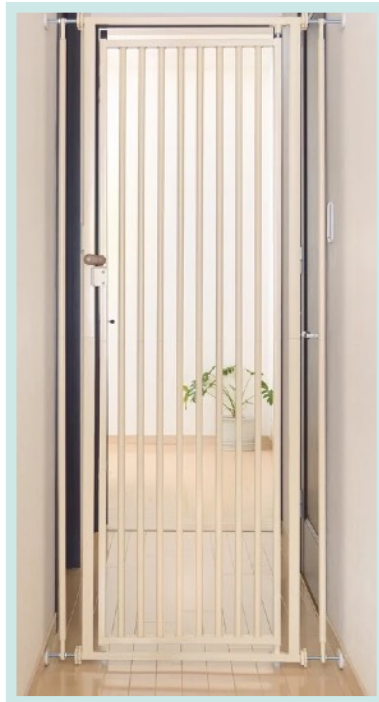

Cons - price, hard to put up

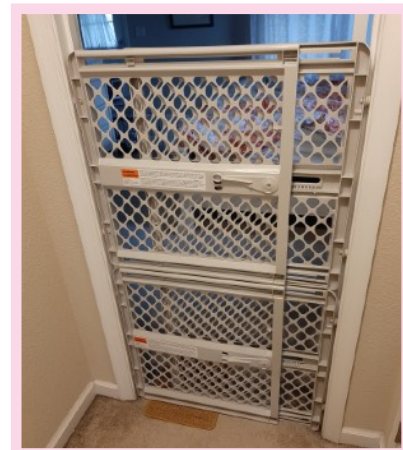


Toddleroo by North States 26"-42" Supergate

Explorer: [Link](#) - Double stacked.

Pros - inexpensive, tension based

Cons - you must put up and take down each time you enter and leave the room. Cats can climb.

Pros - inexpensive, not permanent

Cons - cats can climb and rip, I suggest using a gate as well.
